THE HAND THAT ROCKS

The ON-TREND TRIBAL tips

Bold patterns smashed it on the S/S 2011 catwalk, and brave girls rock the look on talons too.



STEP 1 Lock in colour and create a smooth, even base by first prepping your nails – we like

LCN Base Coat, £4.80.



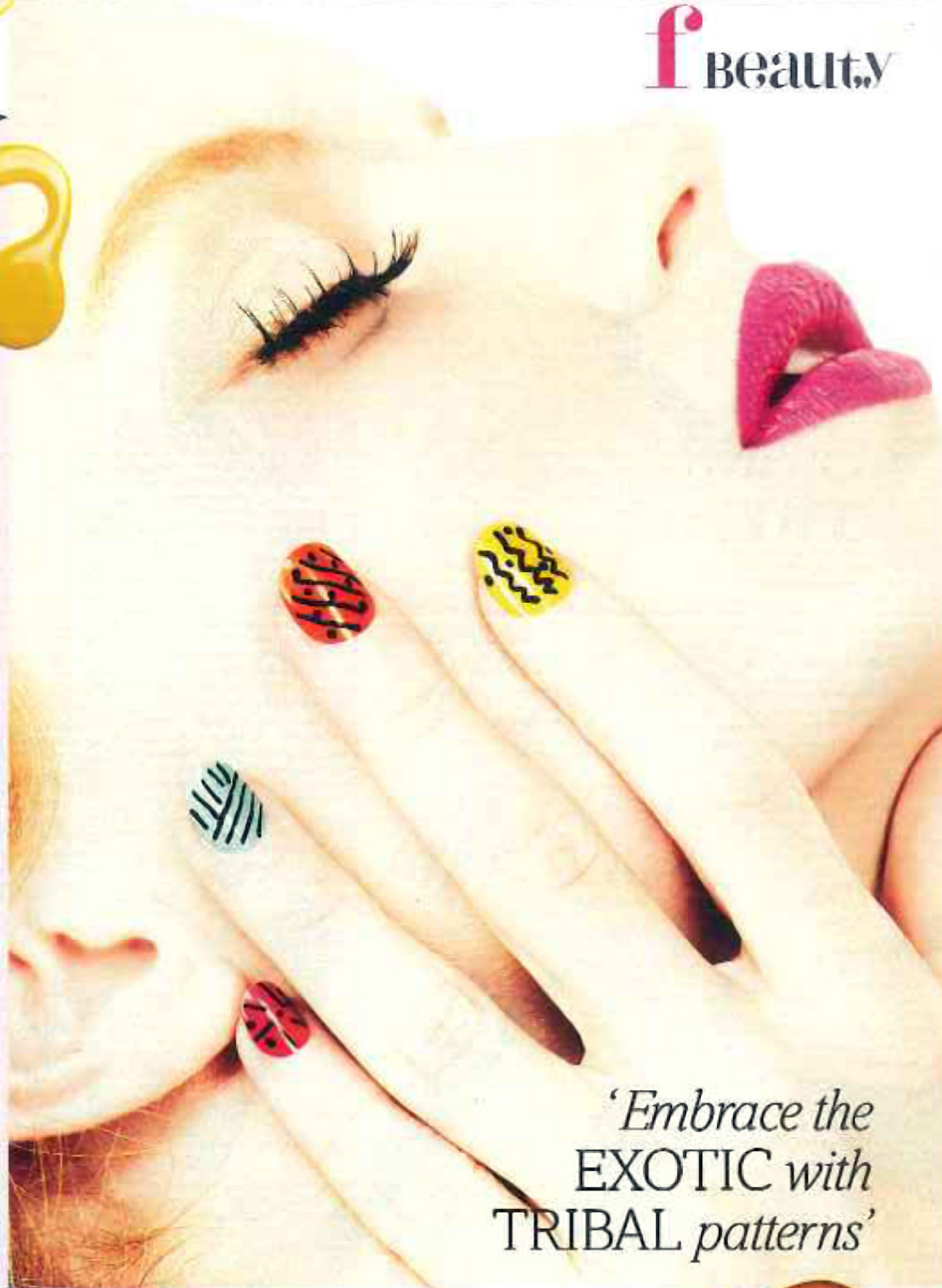
STEP 2 Pick a colour and apply two thin layers of polish to each nail. Clash this season's brights such

as Nails Inc Nail Polish in Atomic by Fabulous and in OMPI by Fabulous with Bourjois So Laque Ultra Shine Nail Enamel in Jaune Tendre, £5.99 (1).



STEP 3 Leave until touch-dry (around 15 minutes), then, using a fine-tip permanent marker

(removable with nail polish remover), get doodling. Take your inspiration from tribal markings, as seen at Diane von Furstenberg and Missoni.

The QUEEN OF THE JUNGLE nails

Who says a leopard never changes its spots? Take a walk on the wild side by mixing and matching your fave shades for a look that's grrreat!



STEP 1 Choose the base shade for your look – we used Nails Inc Nail Polish in Atomic by Fabulous (2) – and begin by painting a single layer on your nails. For a smooth finish, avoid loading your brush with too

much polish and start with one stroke down the centre of the nail and follow with a stroke on either side.



STEP 2 Using a super-fine brush like Rio Nails Detailing Brush, £1.99, or an ultra-thin eyeliner brush, dot your second colour on to nails.

We love Max Factor Max Colour Effect Mini Nail Polish in Soft Toffee, £3.99. Apply a

small amount to avoid smudging, but don't worry about mistakes – it's not meant to look perfect.



STEP 3

To complete the look, we used Modclic Owa Nail Art Pen in black, £6, to create an outline by tracing roughly around the dots.

For a similar effect, try using a fine-tip permanent marker pen. →
